From SPLTZ, the route proceeds to MESCA (triangle symbol) with a heading of 090° and a distance of 1.3 NM. Finally, it reaches NOCHI (diamond symbol) with a heading of 065° and a distance of 3.8 NM. A north arrow is located near the top of the chart.

TAKEOFF RUNWAY 11L: Climb heading 123° to 3200 MSL, then direct BURRO, thence. . .
